Our boot camp strives to guide participants to reach their highest potential. We work to uncover the young & elegant/young & debonair by enhancing the qualities and talents of each youth. For that reason, our youth are called Young & Elegant/Young & Debonair because of the growth they will experience as a part of the program. Our program focuses on just to name a few:

- College Readiness •Etiquette •Character Building •Why grades are important
- Community Service •Financial Literacy •Budgeting •Public Speaking •Reading Literacy
- 200 volunteer hours (high school students) •Ballroom Dancing •Dance •Drama

Opportunities are provided for our youth to give back to the community, attend influential workshops hosted by our volunteers and guests, and participate in social outings that encourage friendship and fun.

We will meet from January 9, 2022 through August 21, 2022, Sunday's from 5 pm to 7 pm, culminating with the Cotillion Ball. **From January 9, 2022 to April 17, 2022, we will meet virtually via zoom. We will resume meeting at our 2140 Holbrook our official headquarters in Hamtramck, MI, on Sunday, April 24, 2022 at 5 p.m.**

To join, all prospective participants MUST submit: **1) A completed application, 2) their most recent report card, and 3) Early registration \$40.00 through the end of January, 2022 non-refundable registration fee. Normal** Registration ends on Sunday, January 30, 2022. Registration fee can be made by cash, cash app: \$mittfl or money order. **No personal checks will be accepted. 4) Submit (2) letters of recommendation must accompany application packet.** (Cannot be a relative). **5) A typed (double space essay of a minimum 250 words entitled "Expectation of a Cotillion/Debonair participant". (Due with application packet) We encourage early registration. You can mail your packet in with registration fee.**

Requirements

1. **All** participants are required to complete 50 hours of community service to remain active.
2. **All** participants are required to attend all sessions to remain active.
3. **There is a \$250 financial responsibility fee per participant which covers workshop/community service materials, guest speakers, refreshments, t-shirts for participants, and general overhead.**
4. **All** participants are required to have **\$250 paid by April 30, 2022. Total financial responsibility is \$250 per participant. Those who participate in the fundraisers a portion of your financial responsibility will be reduced. All financial responsibility balances are due by April 30, 2022. There is a sponsorship package available that you can use to help with your financial responsibility.**



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- 5. **All** participants are required to participate in all fundraising activities this will help to defray a portion of your financial responsibility.
- 6. **Cotillion Ball** requirements **each participant is responsible for 3 ads for souvenir booklet and 8 tickets (tickets are \$25 per person for Cotillion Ball). No exceptions**
